ROCKHAMPTON GOLF CLUB INC. PACE OF PLAY POLICY

Effective **1st October 2009**, the following P of P times will apply to all club golf events at the Rockhampton Golf Club.

DEFINITION OF 'PACE OF PLAY' (P of P)

The Pace of Play shall be defined as the total time taken (Including refreshments breaks, toiletries, time looking for lost balls etc) from initial tee off to the final hole of the day (referred to as the completion of a round)

Preferred Pace of Play playing times for 18 and 9 holes shall be 4 and 2 hours respectively averaging 13 minutes 20 seconds per hole.

DEFINING PACE OF PLAY

- (a) Playing groups shall keep up with the playing groups in front.
- (b) Playing groups shall keep within a maximum playing time allowance to be measured at each tee by multiplying the number of holes played by 15 minutes and added to the groups' actual tee off time.
- (i.e. Tee Time = No. Holes Played X 15 minutes + Tee Off time)

EXAMPLE – For each 18 hole game event, the maximum Pace of Play allowance is 4 hours 30 minutes or 270 minutes in total. Divide by 18 equals 15 minutes per hole. This calculation provides a reasonable average time allowance to play each hole. Players should be commencing their final 9 holes no later than 2 hours and 15 minutes after their original tee off time.

PLAYER TEE OFF TIME

Player Tee Off Time is the time players actually tee off the start of their game and will be when the Starter has called players to the Tee and a Clear Fairway exists to play.

IDENTIFYING A SLOW GROUP OR PLAYER

A slow playing group is identified by being one clear fairway behind the group in front and/or being behind the scheduled maximum allowance time position on the course. (ie. 15 minutes per hole) Clearly, a group's position in the field is immediately behind the group in front, not in front of the group behind. Course Marshals will monitor group's position in the field after the completion of the 4th hole of play. Field Times Indicator Table below illustrates position in field times.

DEFINITION OF A CLEAR FAIRWAY

On par fours and par threes – when the group in front has cleared the putting surface. On par fives – when the group in front has sufficiently cleared the fairway or the green allowing the following group to safely play their shots.

THE HALFWAY HOUSE (Spike Bar)

In all instances, the break between the first and second nine is incorporated in the total Pace of Play time. The break is not a "given" but a privilege. It must be earned by playing the first nine holes within the maximum Pace of Play timelines including the time to be spent at the Halfway House. Time at Halfway House is to be no greater than 7 minutes. If Players do not play their first nine holes within the Pace of Play timelines they should proceed directly to their next tee in preparation for tee-off. Players should be commencing their final 9 holes no later than 2 hours and 15 minutes after their original tee off time.

APPLICATION OF PENALTY

If a group is observed to be falling behind and exceeding pace of play guidelines they will receive a Pace of Play warning and the marshal will note their names and the position on the course. The group will be given two holes to catch up the players in front. If no improvement has been made after two holes, the group will receive an "Official Warning for Slow Play" by the Course Marshall. Their names will be noted as will their position on the course and the time the warning was issued. The Course Marshal will mark the Starters Sheet accordingly and advise the group that they have a further two holes to improve their position in the field. If the group makes no endeavour to improve their position in the field the Course Marshal will again note the names, the course position and the time the second warning was issued. The Starter's Sheet will once again be marked indicating a second warning was required. In the instance where a second "Official Warning" has been issued on the same day, the Course Marshal shall immediately communicate the warning to the Club Captain. Penalties as per the rules of Golf.

WHO CAN APPLY PENALTIES

The Match Committee has the authority to apply penalties.

ABUSIVE LANGUAGE OR INSULTING BEHAVIOUR BY A PLAYER TOWARDS A MARSHAI

Any reports of abuse, insults or intimidation towards a Course Marshall will result in the offending player/s being formally requested to attend a meeting with the Match Committee to explain their actions. In appropriate cases the Match Committee may refer the offending player's behaviour to the Committee to be dealt with in accordance with the constitution of the Rockhampton Golf Club Inc.

APPEALING PENALTIES

Any member has the right to appeal the penalty issued by contacting the Club Captain within twenty-four hours of the penalty being issued. The Management Committee will review the facts and a decision will be made. Please note that being the faster player in a known slow group is no defence.

Repeat offenders are deemed to be those players who have received more than six "Official Warnings for Slow Play' in one calendar year. The Club Captain shall refer to the Committee to be dealt with in accordance with the Constitution of the Rockhampton Golf Club Inc.

CALL UP HOLES

Players should <u>consider</u> calling up following group of players to the 7th and 11th holes. However if the next tee is free, putt out and move on. Protection for players will be provided on the 11th hole with all players required to stand behind the safety nets provided.

CALLING THROUGH

Players are reminded of the etiquette associated with looking for lost balls in the rough or in the hazard (water course/banks etc). If a ball is lost in general play and it is obvious that it is going to take sometime to find, the following players should be called through. Players are

reminded that they have 3 minutes to find a lost ball before it has to be replayed or abandoned.

PLAYERS LATE TO THE TEE

Late to the tee shall be deemed to be anyone who is not ready to hit off at their scheduled tee time. If a player is not present at the designated tee time and the fairway is clear the remaining players must hit off, unless the stand-by group is ready and agrees to move up. If players present have teed off and departed the tee, the late player will forfeit place in field – starter will re-schedule player to a vacant position if possible. In a four-ball or teams event the late arrival may only commence play from the next full hole the group will play. All players are required to have registered with the Starter and ready to play at least 15 minutes prior to their 'stipulated hit off time'.

MALE MEMBERS / LADY MEMBERS / JUNIOR AND SENIOR MEMBERS

All players are to be treated exactly the same in playing the golf course. All players will abide by the Pace of Play Policies during competition. The introduction of a Pace of Play Policy is a necessary move as the Committee endeavours to make a 5 hour round of golf a thing of the past. All members are encouraged to make other members aware of this policy in order to effect a change in attitude across the entire membership with regards to Slow Play.

ADVICE FOR SPEEDING UP PLAY

- · Mark score cards at the next tee.
- When safe, let shortest hitters hit off the tee first.
- · Walk briskly between shots and greens to tees.
- On wrong fairway, other fairway players have right of way.
 Correct Fairway players may on the occasion concede right of way when safe and their Pace of Play not impeded.
- Don't play golf car golf. Utilise short walks to and from balls, leave player with club and go find your ball.

- Those with golf cars go ahead and locate balls of group.
- Not leaving golf cars and buggies in front of a green but at the back towards the next green.
- Non stroke events Pick up ball when unable to score.
- Prepare for your shot while others in the group are playing theirs.
- Take only one practice swing.
- · Mark your ball for early and ease of identification.
- Players on green, agree to putt out whilst waiting for last player traversing green for ball or putter.
- Play a provisional ball, if original ball may be lost outside a hazard or out of bounds.
- Size up your putt while others are putting and being ready when it is your turn to play.
- Lost ball declarations Call through waiting following playing groups immediately.

JUNIOR GOLF

The Rockhampton Golf Club caters for Junior players of all ages and abilities. Competitions are organised for 3, 6, 9 and 18 hole players. Juniors play Sunday mornings with the following tee off times:

Junior events include Stroke play, foursomes and match play with the major competitions and tournaments being:

Juniors also compete in tournaments at other Junior Golf Clubs around the Central Queensland area.

The Junior development program includes beginners' clinics at the beginning of the year, rules and coaching clinics, "step-up days" to the next division. Individual coaching is available at charge through the Club Professional, Ian Collins. Booking for coaching lessons is essential.

The Rockhampton Juniors welcome sponsors for their monthly medals and for the Open and Closed Championships conducted each year.

CONDITIONS FOR JUNIORS TO PLAY IN ADULT COMPETITIONS

The following criteria are required for junior players to be eligible to play in adult competitions:

- Juniors must have an AGU handicap (Golf link)
- At least 6 months experience playing 18 hole junior competitions at Rockhampton or elsewhere and have experience at Junior Open events.
- Have passed a rules and etiquette test given by Junior Coordinator or member of Junior Committee.
- Have been "passed" by the Junior Coordinator in being capable of playing in adult events – speed of play and etiquette on course is up to adult standard.
- Juniors must be of High School age.

- For older juniors, if not accompanied by a parent or other adult, a letter written by their parents to the RGC Committee stating that their child can play in an adult comp on their own.
- 1 junior player per group until 16, unless 2 players are accompanied by parents / guardians two father / son combinations, for example.

VISITORS SHOULD NOTE THAT USUAL GREEN FEES ARE ALSO PAYABLE.

Players to arrange own partners and times of play. An online booking system is in operation at the Pro Shop and at the Clubhouse. Games

for Visitors will need to be arranged through the Pro Shop. The official competition is over 18 Holes unless notified by Committee.

Presentation of trophies will be at 6.00 p.m.

ROCKHAMPTON GOLF CLUB INCORPORATED SUBSCRIPTION YEAR

From 2003, the subscription year shall commence on the first day of April in each year.

Persons admitted as new members after the 1st day of July each year shall be required to pay the annual subscription assessed on a pro rata basis.

Members are reminded that in accordance with the Club's By-Laws, no member shall be eligible to compete in any competition whilst he or she is more than one calendar month in arrears. Student membership and Over 80's Membership is now also available.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Match Committee is in charge of all play on the course and reserves the right to alter the programme or method of play at any time.

All play is governed by the Rules of Golf and the Clubs By-Laws.

A protest or dispute in connection with any competition or match shall be made, in writing to the Match Committee immediately upon completion of play in such competition or match.

The rules of golf and the local rules of the Club are the rules of play.

Major Men's Competitions. In the event of a tie winner will be determined by sudden death play-off on the day, Light and Weather permitting.

The Match Committee's decision in all competitions is final.

Handicaps – Members who have not qualified for an AGU or ALGU handicap are ineligible to compete in Events.

Hours of Play - Competitors may play in the programmed competition of the day as stipulated on the online booking system.

Players must take direction from the Course Marshals at all times.

STARTING

Players may only start competition by direction of the starter.

Players should report to the starter at least 15 minutes before the time of play.

All competitors must be at the tee ready to hit off at their appointed time. Failure to comply will invoke Rule 6-3

COMPETITIONS AND HANDICAPS

HANDICAPS: The Club operates a MiClub Golf System. All competitions are through this system. Nominations to play in competitions are to be done on the appropriate time sheets in MiClub Golf.

REGULAR CLUB COMPETITIONS:

(Unless otherwise indicated)

Saturday:

Men: Members and visitors. Women: Members and visitors.

Sunday:

3rd Sunday of Month - Golfer of the Year - Feb - Nov

Wednesday:

Women: Members and visitors – timesheet in One Golf.. When nominating, Members should carefully note the time they have nominated to play and from which tee. Members are requested **not** to nominate players other than themselves, unless specifically requested to do so by that player.

Players who have nominated and find they cannot play are requested to cancel, so players wanting a game can be allotted that time.

VISITING MEMBERS: Members require their Golf link number so that current handicap details are available.

Medal days – only fully paid Members of RGC may win the Monthly Medal for A, B or C grades.

Members of reciprocal clubs and all other visitors are excluded from playing in all closed events etc. Club Championships and Honour Board events.

RETURN OF CARDS: All competition cards must be signed by the marker of the card and the player and must be entered into the terminal and placed in appropriate box no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the game. NCR cards not to be put through terminals

NON - COMPETITORS: On days when competitions arranged by the Match Committee are played, any member not taking part can play only when and where directed by the starter.

HANDICAP ADJUSTMENTS FOR VARIOUS COMPETITIONS

Single Match Play – Full difference between the respective handicaps, for men and women with lowest marker playing from scratch. See back of scorecard for index.

Four Ball Match play – Lowest marker to play from scratch, the rest to take full difference between respective handicaps.

Foursomes - Half of combined handicap- fractions to count.

Stableford & Par - Full handicap.

Ambrose 4 players one-eighth of aggregate – fractions to count.
3 players one-sixth of aggregate – fractions to count
2 players ne-quarter of aggregate - fractions to count.

TROPHIES

DONORS: The Management Committee expresses their appreciation of the generosity of those members who have so kindly donated

trophies for the competitions to be contested this season. Winners are requested to personally thank their trophy donors.

MAJOR CLUB TROPHIES: Only Members are eligible for monthly Medal and Honour Board Events.

Should a visitor(s) have the best score of the day they will receive a Club Trophy.

Other Trophies: Singles: 4BBB - Members and Country members are all eliqible to win the trophy of the day

NEAREST THE PIN CLUB SHOTS: the golf balls in these events are included in the competition fees.

Pro shots and Rundown are also included in Green Fees. Hole in One Jackpot \$1.00 extra to be paid at Pro Shop prior to playing. Members Only.



GENERAL NOTES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF MEMBERS (BY-LAWS):

PRIORITY ON THE COURSE -

- In the absence of special rules or unless a four ball event is in progress, two ball matches have precedence and are entitled to pass through any three or four ball match.
- 2. A single player has no standing and should give way to a match of any kind.
- 3. Any match playing an entire round has precedence over a match playing a shorter round.
- 4. If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole, it should invite the match following to pass through. It is the duty of the players "going through" to make up the lost ground as quickly as possible.

PLAYERS PLACED ON THEIR HONOUR – As Golf is a game where normally there is no Referee or Umpire, Members are placed on their honour "to play the game" as it not only concerns an opponent but (in a competition round) it concerns the whole field. Therefore, they must honour and observe all the rules and immediately notify opponents of any infringements for penalties they may incur.

INFRINGEMENTS TO BE REPORTED – it is the duty of every member to bring to the notice of the Committee any infringements of the Rules of Etiquette of Golf.

CARE OF THE COURSE:

- 1. Carry a sand bucket at all times to repair divots on fairways/tees.
- 2. Repair all ball marks on the greens.
- Removal of balls from the hole with the putter head is not permissible because of damage this may cause to the hole.

SLOW PLAY: In the interests of avoiding slow play:

- Keep up with the group in front and not with the group behind.
 In the event of a lost ball, call the following group through immediately.
- 2. **Leave buggies** on the side of the green nearest the access to the next tee.

COMPLAINTS: All complaints shall be made in writing to a Committee member.

SUPPLY OF LIQUOR: No liquor shall be sold or supplied to any person under 18 years of age.

MEMBERS PROPERTY: Members are responsible for the safety of their own property left on the course or in the Clubhouse. The club provides insurance cover in respect of Members' property for fire and theft within the Clubhouse and the Professional's Shop. This cover does not include the car parks and golf course. Members would be well advised to cover other contingencies on their own account.

DANGEROUS WEATHER: In the event of a thunder storm/lightning during play a horn will be sounded to notify players they must leave the course immediately and return to the club house.

GENERAL

MOTORISED BUGGIES: Operation Rules:

- Buggies are NOT to be driven or parked inside the marked line near tees, greens and bunkers. Do NOT drive between the green and bunker.
- A common sense approach to buggy driving should avoid undue damage to the course and make the game more pleasant for all.
- Motorised Carts are permissible on the golf course except at times designated by the Committee.

CHARITY DAYS AND SOCIAL CLUBS

Special Charity events scheduled throughout the year will take precedence over **ALL** Social Clubs. Social Clubs affected by Charity events will need to re-programme **their event** to another available day.

Members have right of way over all Social Clubs at all times.

MOBILE PHONES

In consideration of others, the use of mobile phones on the golf course is strongly discouraged, with exception to scoring using Mi Score.

PROGRAMME 2022 LADIES COMPETITION

This program is subject to alteration by the Match Committee.

All Match Committee decisions will be final.

The W.G.A. recommends that three cards be returned each season for handicap purposes.

VISITING LADIES – Are eligible to play in all competitions, but may not win Monthly Medals or Championships. To receive a club trophy, visiting ladies must provide Golflink number.

WGQ BROOCH In conjunction with Monthly Medals. Best three of Six (6) Rounds – March to August. \$3.50 per player.

QLD INTERNATIONAL BOWL RAISES FUNDS FOR WGA International and Australian events and tours (best of 3 rounds) \$3.50 per player.

MEDAL COMPETITIONS - Wednesday Div 1 & Div 2 & Saturdays - Monthly Medal-one medal only.

WOMENS MATCHPLAY 2022

Singles Matchplay – is full difference between the player's stroke handicaps. If the difference exceeds 18, players shall receive 2 strokes per hole where applicable.

Fourball Matchplay – full difference between the stroke play handicaps of the players. The lowest marker concedes strokes to the others including her partner. Players receive 2 strokes per hole where applicable.
